**Purpose:** This dinner is organized and hosted by Student Veterans of America (SVA). In the context of the strategic partnership that Google has been exploring with Ohio State, the company leveraged their connections to SVA to i) introduce their leaders to President Carter who serves on the SVA board of directors, and ii) have a dinner discussion with several Ohio State leaders ahead of our visioning session the following day.

This dinner is bringing together SVA, Google, Ohio State, and Hiring Our Heroes. These organizations are in Columbus for roundtables on AI and state policy impacting student veterans. SVA described this dinner as a relaxed opportunity to connect, share perspectives, and continue the conversations that are shaping our collective work.

Since late summer 2025, Ohio State has been exploring a strategic partnership with Google that would leverage our mutual investments and strengths in AI. On November 18, Google is bringing nine leaders to our Innovation District for a visioning session with Ohio State leaders, including those attending the private dinner. We hope to leave the visioning session with an alignment on what we could co-create together and tangible next steps. Other companies that we have engaged with a similar goal in mind include Microsoft (Nov 12) and Apple.

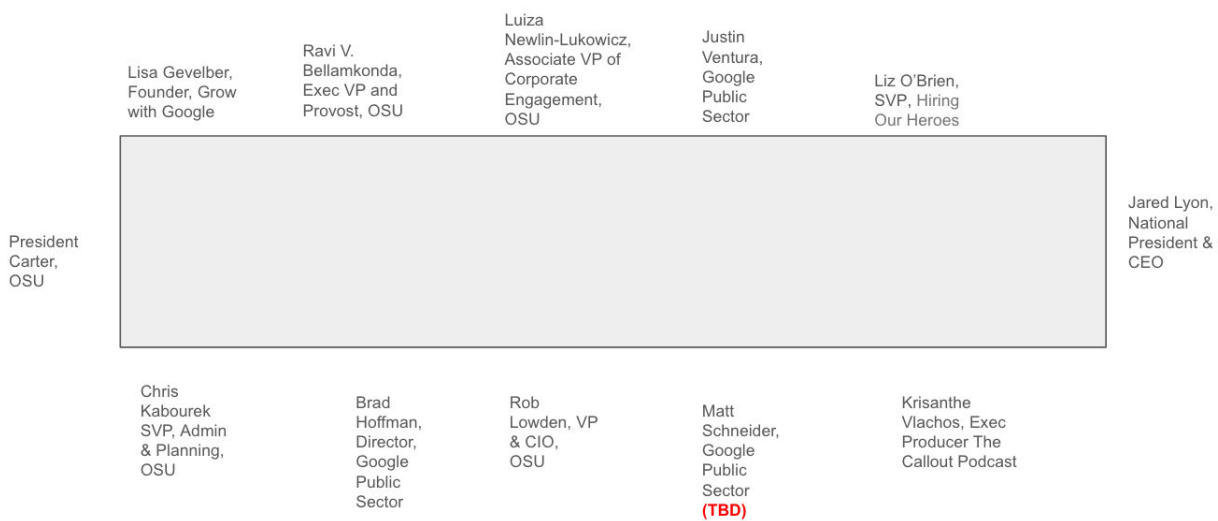

## Google

**Google LLC** is a global leader developing and delivering a wide range of technology products and services, including search, advertising, cloud computing, software, and hardware.

- **Headquarters:** Googleplex, Mountain View, California, USA
- **Parent Company:** Alphabet Inc. (since 2015, following a major corporate restructuring)
- **CEO:** Sundar Pichai (also CEO of Alphabet Inc. since 2019)

**Google's Investments in Ohio:** Since entering Ohio in 2019, Google has invested \$7.2 billion in data center infrastructure across Central Ohio including [New Albany, Lancaster and Columbus](#). In 2023, the company committed an additional \$1.7 billion to expand existing facilities and develop new campuses. In 2024, Google announced a further \$2.3 billion investment to enhance these campuses.

These facilities support Google's global services: Search, Gmail, Maps, YouTube, Cloud, and AI capabilities. They facilitate faster content delivery across the U.S. and provide local cloud infrastructure for major clients like the State of Ohio, Nationwide, Victoria's Secret, Wendy's, and Huntington Bank.

**Grow with Google's** mission is to close the digital skills gap and drive workforce competitiveness by providing accessible, job-relevant training at scale. By combining online learning, credentialing programs, and partnerships with community organizations, the initiative strengthens talent pipelines, supports small business growth, and promotes inclusive economic participation in the digital economy.

**Google.org (the Google Foundation)** is the philanthropic arm of Google, established to leverage the company's resources of funding, technology, and expertise, to address pressing global challenges. Its mission focuses on creating social impact on a scale by supporting nonprofits, social enterprises, and community initiatives. Key areas of investment include education and digital skills, economic opportunity, crisis response, and advancing equity. Since 2006, Google has given more than \$14 million to organizations and nonprofits in Ohio.

Google has been selective with strategic philanthropic support; however, the AI boom has ignited significantly more interest in education. By offering access to advanced AI tools like the Gemini chatbot and structured AI training programs, Google aims to democratize AI literacy and research capabilities across institutions, empowering students and faculty to innovate and compete in a rapidly evolving technology landscape.

**Google recently committed [\\$1 billion over three years to AI education initiatives](#).** This commitment includes providing AI training, tools, and cloud resources to universities and colleges, along with grants and cloud computing credits.

### **Ohio State's Relationship with Google:**

Google's interest in Ohio State has grown drastically, which provides an opportunity to elevate one-off low-level sponsorships and technology donations to a multi-year enterprise agreement.

In August 2025, Ohio State joined 100 other universities that opted to participate in **Google's AI Accelerator**, which provides certain tools and training to our students, faculty, and staff. On August 21, **Google Public Sector** hosted "Data & AI Day" at Ohio Stadium, an event designed to help Ohio State instructors, researchers and staff learn about how Google Productivity Tools complement the university's AI Fluency initiative. Students, faculty and staff can now [access secure versions of Google](#)

[AI tools](#), ensuring that Google does not save or share the information they enter. Importantly, for the first time in years, Google is recruiting on our campus this fall.

**Procurement**

Ohio State has a procurement relationship with Google, though it pales in comparison to that with Microsoft. Ohio State’s cumulative spend on Google since 2020 is **\$1.1 million**, compared to \$48.3 million for Microsoft (these numbers include the Wexner Medical Center).

**Research:**

No known significant sponsored research partnerships with Ohio State.

**Philanthropy:**

- Google’s lifetime giving to Ohio State is \$1.58 million. Nearly \$1 million of this total is designated to various projects in the College of Engineering, including their most recent gift of \$50,000 to support the work of Professor Ness Shroff.
- In November 2025, Google committed \$125K to the College of Engineering through the giving arm of the Ohio data centers (Allyson Eastman, Google Social Impact and Community Development Senior Manager). The original request was \$500K.
- Their largest gift to OSU was \$150K for the Google Research Fund for Political Science. Google has also made a \$100K gift to the WMC Cardiometabolic Health Fund.

**Talent**

As of November 2025, 566 Ohio State alumni are employed at Google (0.3% of their workforce).

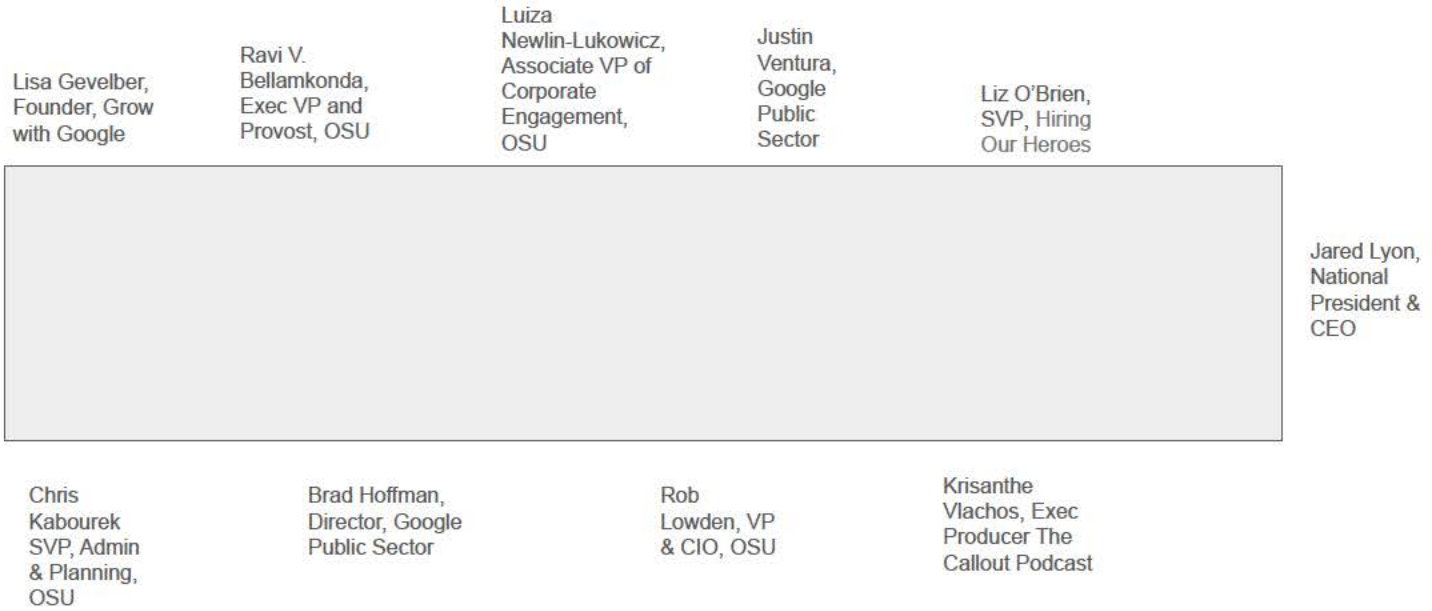

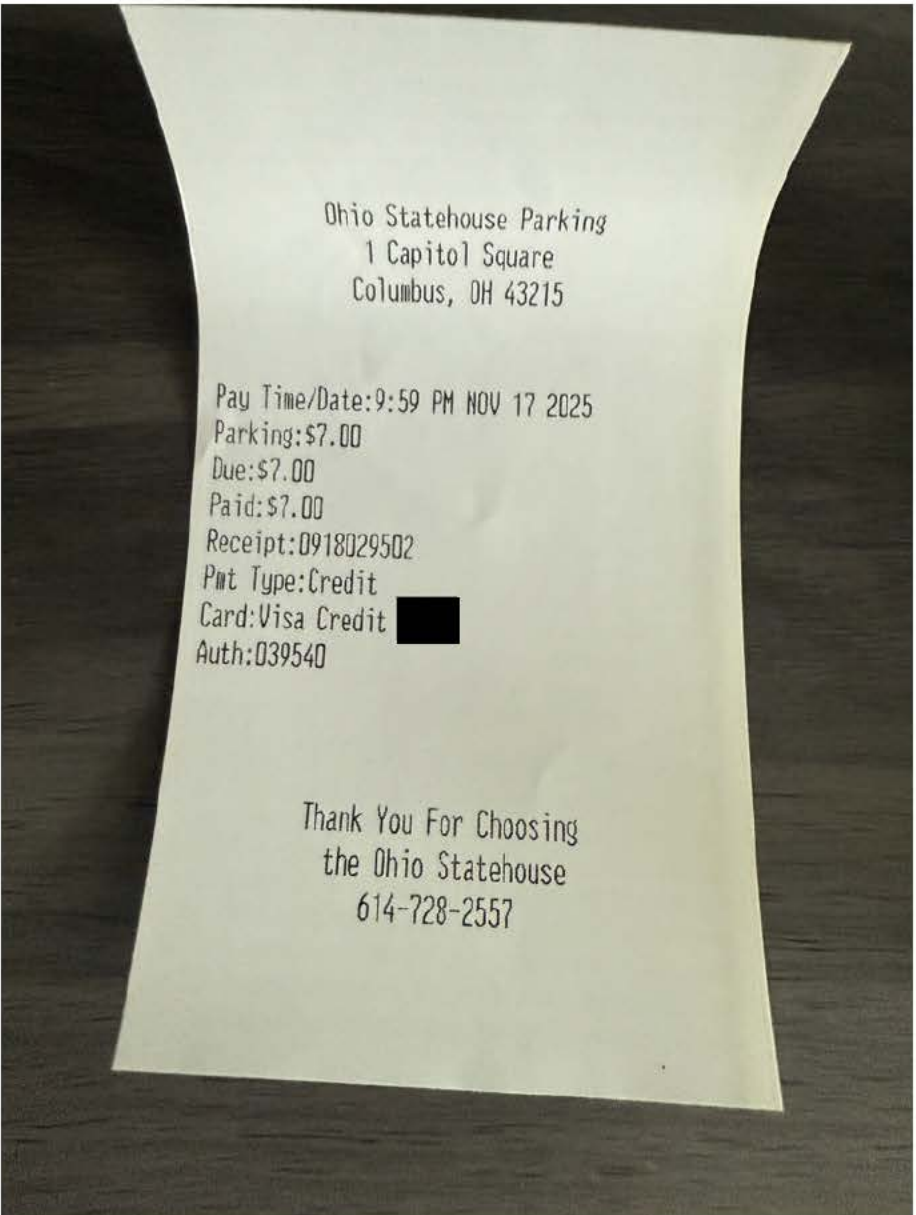
